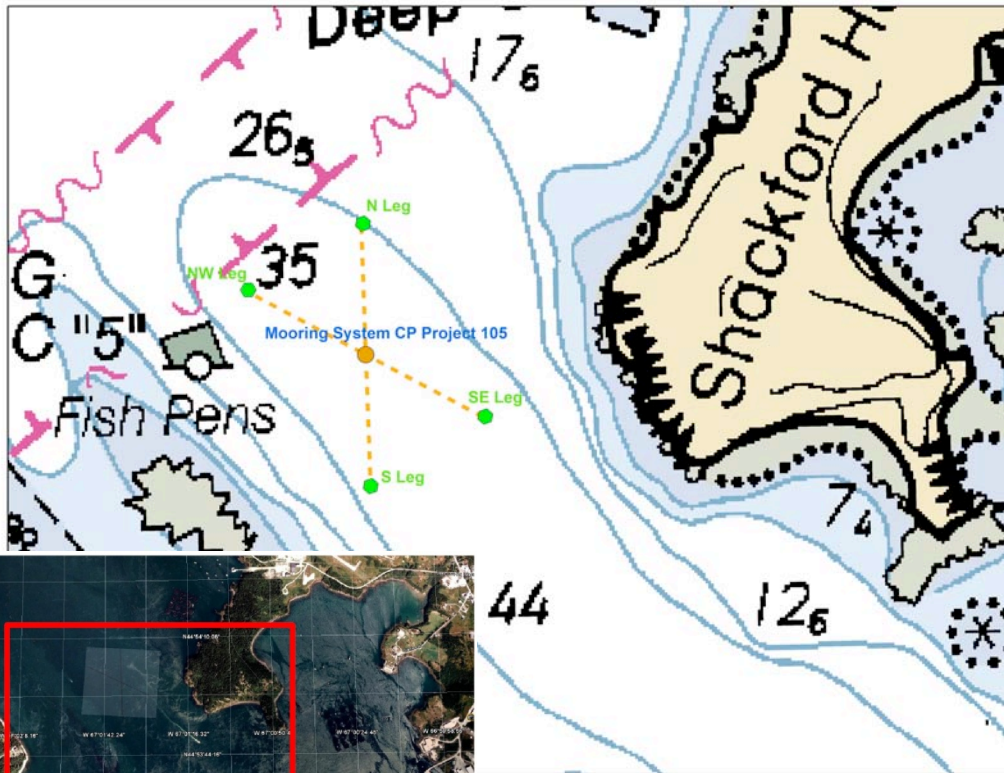


# Notice to Mariners: Temporary Mooring Cobscook Bay



## Details of Temporary Mooring System

- A four leg, single point mooring system.
- All site work authorized by relevant local and state permits.
- **Anchor locations**
  - Mooring buoy

Ocean Renewable Power Company, as part of a tidal energy demonstration project, has installed a temporary mooring system in Cobscook Bay, just off-shore from Shackford Head and Cooper Island Ledge.

On-water activities to support the project are expected to begin by March 2, 2010, and the mooring is expected to be removed no later than September 30, 2010.

Such activities will include regular presence at the mooring aboard the research vessel, the *Energy Tide 2*, performing research work including environmental testing and monitoring. Other permitted activities including the periodic transport of personnel and equipment from the test site, is not expected to impact the navigability of the channel or commercial fishing activities in the area.
